My Reasons/ Understanding Why It Could Be 'His/her Space':




The place is well connected with, entrance, verandah, tv, sitting place in living room and platform.

flooring material is the same as inside the house and also regular cleaning creates a feeling that somebody is inside the house, there is also a level difference which creates someone's territory.




The place is deep and far in the house because of the organization, it creates privacy.





Wife busy in house work and daughter is either in school or in bedroom so the place works as private place.












The most of the time she spends there because of the such activities.






It is in the private zone of the house also door and corner create more privacy.







It has visual connectivity to other parts of the house and outside as well.






Study table and his books are in the room and no other common thigs are in the room so usually nobody comes to the room



Good view because of the big window and also sill level is low.







Privacy is different in both house type.in bunglow the floor is dividing the part. Upper floor is private and ground floor is public. While in apartment public and private distinction created by the zonig the area. Like the front area is public zone and as you go deep it will be private zone.



In bunglow because of such organization you getting the backyard / free spaces in back which is visually private space but fo someone who is staying in home can approach that area by the margin around the house ,it is open and approachable are so any one can approach it , so he/she need to close the room for privacy.


If you are sitting in corner in bedroom he/she feel private because in flat there is clear sense that this is private area I should not approach it.

Material
